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Trump – Harris Remain Tied in 2-Way Harris Leads by 1% in a 8-Way - Post Debate (Slotkin 48%-Rogers 45%)

LANSING, Mich. — Former President Donald Trump and /vice President Kamala Harris are deadlocked at 48% in a trial ballot question for President in 2024 according to an exclusive statewide poll of Michigan conducted for **MIRS and Michigan News Source** by **Mitchell Research & Communications, Inc.** This is exactly where the race between Biden and Trump was June 3rd.

In an eight-way trial ballot test Trump (46%) trailed Harris (47%) by one percent. Robert F. Kennedy (2%) and Green Party candidate Jill Stein (1%) are the only candidates to get any support.

The poll was conducted Wednesday September 11, 2024 **after** the ABC News Presidential Debate the night before. It was conducted entirely by text messaging a randomly selected list of registered voter's cell phones and directing them to a SurveyMonkey poll (MMS-Web). After collecting the data, it was weighted by age, gender, party affiliation, race, education, and result in the 2020 presidential election to reflect what we estimate will be the turnout in November 2024 in Michigan. .

The poll of (N=580 Likely Voters) has a Margin of Error is + or – 4.07% at the 95% level of confidence. Margin of error for Harris voters is (N=278) is + or – 5.91% at the 95% level of confidence while the M o E on the Trump voters (N=275) is + or – 5.98% at the 95% level of confidence. M o E of independent voters (N=138) is + or – 8.34%. while the M o E of Democrats and Republicans (both N=220) is + or – 6.61.

“The fact that Trump continues to be in a dead heat statistically with Harris, despite the fact that most people, including the respondents to this poll, believe that Harris won the debate on Tuesday night, shows how firmly entrenched the Trump voters are.

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“By a 56% – 29% margin, respondents to this survey, said that Kamala Harris won the debate Tuesday night. Nevertheless, when asked whether or not anyone switched as a result of the debate, 4% switched to Harris to Trump and 3% from Trump Harris this shows a clearly undecided voters so different things in the debate than most of the general public, “Steve Mitchell, President Mitchell Research & Communications said.

In the US Senate race, Elissa Slotkin leads Mike Rogers 48%-45% despite being outspent by a 4:1 margin. Slotkin has solidified Democrat support getting 95% off that vote while Rogers is winning only 87% of GOP voters. Rogers leads 45%-42% with Independents.

Voter Enthusiasm for 2024 General Election

Democrats are now more enthusiastic than Republicans. There is a ten-point gap between Harris voters (80%) who say they are “very enthuse about the election and Republicans (70%)

Voter Reaction to the ABC News Debate

Looking at the 56% – 29%, margin of voters where Harris was the winner of the debate over Donald Trump, the crosstabs are interesting. Ninety-seven percent of Harris voters called her the winner, but so did 14% of the Trump voters and 50% of the undecided voters. You also had 17% of all Republicans and 55% of the independence saying that Kamala Harris was the winner of the debate on Tuesday night.

In a follow-up question, we asked the voters whether or not the debate was important to them in making their decision about their choice for president. Overall, only 18% of the voters said it was very important and another 18% somewhat important. Almost 2/3 of the voters 63%, said it was not very or not at all important in their selection. It was more important to Harris voters where 45%. said it was very or somewhat important compared to only 27% of Trump voters. The bad news for the Harris campaign is that only 6% of the undecided voters said that it was very important and another 13% said it was somewhat important, for a total of 19%.

Finally, we asked them whether or not the debate caused them to switch from one candidate to another. Nine in ten (90%) said that they did not switch, but 4% said they switched from Harris to Trump while 3% said they switched from Trump to Harris. So, despite the fact that, Harris was regarded as the winner by a wide margin, at the end of the day the debate caused one percent more of the respondents to change to Trump than changed to Haris.

Most Important Issue Impacting Vote for President

The top issue that it would impact their vote for president continues to be the economy/inflation (36%) followed by “threats to democracy” (26%) and the border/immigration (18%). .

There are wide differences by party affiliation. Although economy/inflation is the most important issue with 54% of Trump voters and 50% of undecideds, only 18% of Harris voters call it the most important issue.

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It is the opposite with “threat to democracy” where 26% overall said that is the most important issue, but it is only most important issue with 6% of the Trump voters, ,but a whopping 47% of Democratic voters

The third biggest issue statewide is border and immigration, but it is primarily an issue with Republicans (36%) and independents (20%).

When asked who they thought would be best at solving their particular important issue, 50% said Donald Trump compared to 47% that said Harris.
